The National Technical Association (NTA) scholarship of the Hampton Roads Chapter is open to underrepresented minority high school seniors who intend to pursue bachelor degrees in mathematics, science, engineering or technology at any accredited college or university. The scholarship is a one-time, non-renewable award. Applicants must be residents of Gloucester County, Mathews County, James City County, York County, Isle of Wight County, Northampton County, Southampton County, Surry County, Hampton, Newport News, Norfolk, Portsmouth, Virginia Beach, Chesapeake, Poquoson, Suffolk, or Williamsburg. The NTA Hampton Roads Chapter awards at least one \$500 scholarship annually.

The scholarship selection will be based upon the following criteria:

1. Scholastic achievement as determined by high school or overall grade point average (greater than 2.75 out of 4.0) with emphasis on technical course work. An official transcript must be submitted.
2. Two (2) letters of recommendation from high school faculty members in a math, science or technology department, or someone familiar with the student's related work outside of school, such as a research mentor.
3. A biographical sketch of approximately 500 words, which should describe the applicant's (a) purposes in pursuing a science/technology career, (b) extracurricular experiences (community service, part-time/summer employment, enrichment and/or experiential learning programs, etc.), (c) hobbies, and (d) reasons for applying for this scholarship. Applicants may include other facts which will assist in the evaluation of the applicant as a future technical professional.
4. One black and white or color photograph.

The scholarship recipient(s) must be enrolled in a college or university for the entire academic year that the scholarship is awarded. The NTA Hampton Roads Chapter will require official notification of enrollment from the college registrar before the scholarship money will be issued to the recipient(s). Recipient(s) will be notified of their selection before August 1st.

The NTA Hampton Roads Chapter may forward local scholarship applications to our national office for consideration under the NTA National Scholarship Program. The national winner(s) will be invited to attend the NTA National Conference, which is typically held in the fall of each year. The deadline for submitting the NTA Hampton Roads Chapter scholarship application form is **JUNE 30th**.
